AI Literacy - Culminating Prompt Task

Your Task

You've completed all five modules. Using an AI tool of your choice, craft a prompt that generates an infographic of your Top 3 Takeaways from this course, tagged with C21 Canada. Your prompt is the assessment - not just the output.

 **Recommended Tools:** ChatGPT (chatgpt.com), Microsoft Copilot, or Claude (claude.ai).

Your Prompt Must Include

1. **Top 3 Takeaways:** Name the three most important lessons from the course. Be specific - explain what each one actually means.
2. **C21 Canada Tag:** Instruct the AI to include '@C21Canada' or 'c21canada.ca' visibly on the infographic.
3. **Infographic Format:** Ask for a visual layout with sections, headings, or icons - not a paragraph or list.
4. **Audience:** Specify that the infographic is for a general audience - clear and jargon-free.

Building Your Prompt

A strong prompt tells the AI what format to use, what content to include, who the audience is, and what the purpose is. Use this checklist before you submit:


- Have you specified the infographic format?
- Have you named your three takeaways or given enough context for the AI to identify them?
- Have you included the C21 Canada tag requirement?
- Have you described the audience?

Example (make yours more specific): "Create an infographic summarizing the Top 3 Takeaways from a 5-module AI literacy course covering how AI works, academic integrity, bias, prompting, and human-AI collaboration. Use a visual layout with three sections - one per takeaway - each with a heading and 2-3 sentences. Keep it clear for a general audience. Include '@C21Canada' and 'c21canada.ca' in the design."

Remember: This example is intentionally generic. Add your own takeaways and voice - a strong prompt gets a strong result.

Steps

5. **Write down your Top 3 Takeaways** before opening any AI tool.
6. **Write your prompt** using the checklist above.
7. **Run your prompt** and read the output critically.
8. **Iterate** - refine and run it again. You are expected to revise at least once.
9. **Submit:** your final prompt, a screenshot of the infographic, and one sentence on what you changed and why.

 **You've got this.** Everything you need is already in the five modules. Be specific, iterate, and don't settle for the first output.

Rubric

AI Literacy - Final Assessment | 16 points total

Your grade is based on your prompt and your process - not just how the infographic looks. A polished infographic from a vague prompt is worth less than a thoughtful prompt that shows real understanding.
